The **International Journal of Medical Students** (IJMS) is a peer-reviewed open-access scientific journal, created to share the scientific production and experiences of medical students worldwide.

Our objective is to be the primary diffusion organ for medical students, using standards that accredit the process of scientific publication.

The Editorial Board is formed by Mentors, world renowned physician/scientists from the most distinguished institutions; Editors, who are medical students from all continents with experience in research and the publication process, and Advisors who are physicians starting their careers as investigators. In addition, we have the Support Committee of Public Relations and Communications which is the entity responsible for the diffusion of information on IJMS to medical students and physicians worldwide.

WHY BELIEVE IN IJMS?

With the publication from the Evidence-Based Medicine Working Group in 1992 that a new paradigm for medical practice was born: evidence-based medicine, which has had an impact in every aspect of clinical practice and is penetrating medical education, becoming an increasing part of the skills that are needed to practice medicine.

Under this paradigm, the decisions on diagnosis and treatment are no longer based only on clinical expertise, but the evidence to support it. Even so, many medical students and physicians still have trouble with basic principles of research methodology and don't understand fully what trials mean or their publication process.

Scientific journals fulfill a vital part in the generation of knowledge; it is the intermediate step between discoveries made in the laboratory or practice and their inclusion in books. Thus, the first step in making a contribution to medical sciences is through the publication in scientific journals.

Medical student journals do exist, but they often represent specific groups or local associations. And thus, the International Journal for Medical Students was born, to give a voice to the hundreds, thousands, or millions of medical students worldwide, who actively participate in research and contribute on a day to day basis to the progress of medicine, by creating a world renowned platform of the highest scientific quality, for the publication of their work.

We present to you IJMS, sure that this will be one of those defining moments for the history of medical student publications.

PEER-REVIEWERS

Peer-Review is the critical assessment of manuscripts submitted to journals by experts who are not part of the editorial staff. Peer-reviewers evaluate the scientific quality of the articles assigned according to a pre-established format, attach suggestions or modifications necessary to improve the scientific quality of the articles reviewed and determine whether the article should be accepted for publication or not.

PARTNERS

The **Partners of IJMS** are independent, non-governmental and non-political organizations of medical students, of a country or a group of countries, that have adopted IJMS as a recognized publication by their organization and will provide their institutional support.

These associations can publish the abstracts of their Scientific Meetings as Supplement Issues of the Journal, can submit short communications on the outcomes of such meetings for publishing at the following editions of the Journal, and submit other type of articles in the Special Section of the Journal.

They must participate actively in the activities of the journal, attend the meetings proposed by the Executive Committee, submit a minimum of one article for publication in the journal per issue, and include in their internal communications, promotional material of IJMS.




